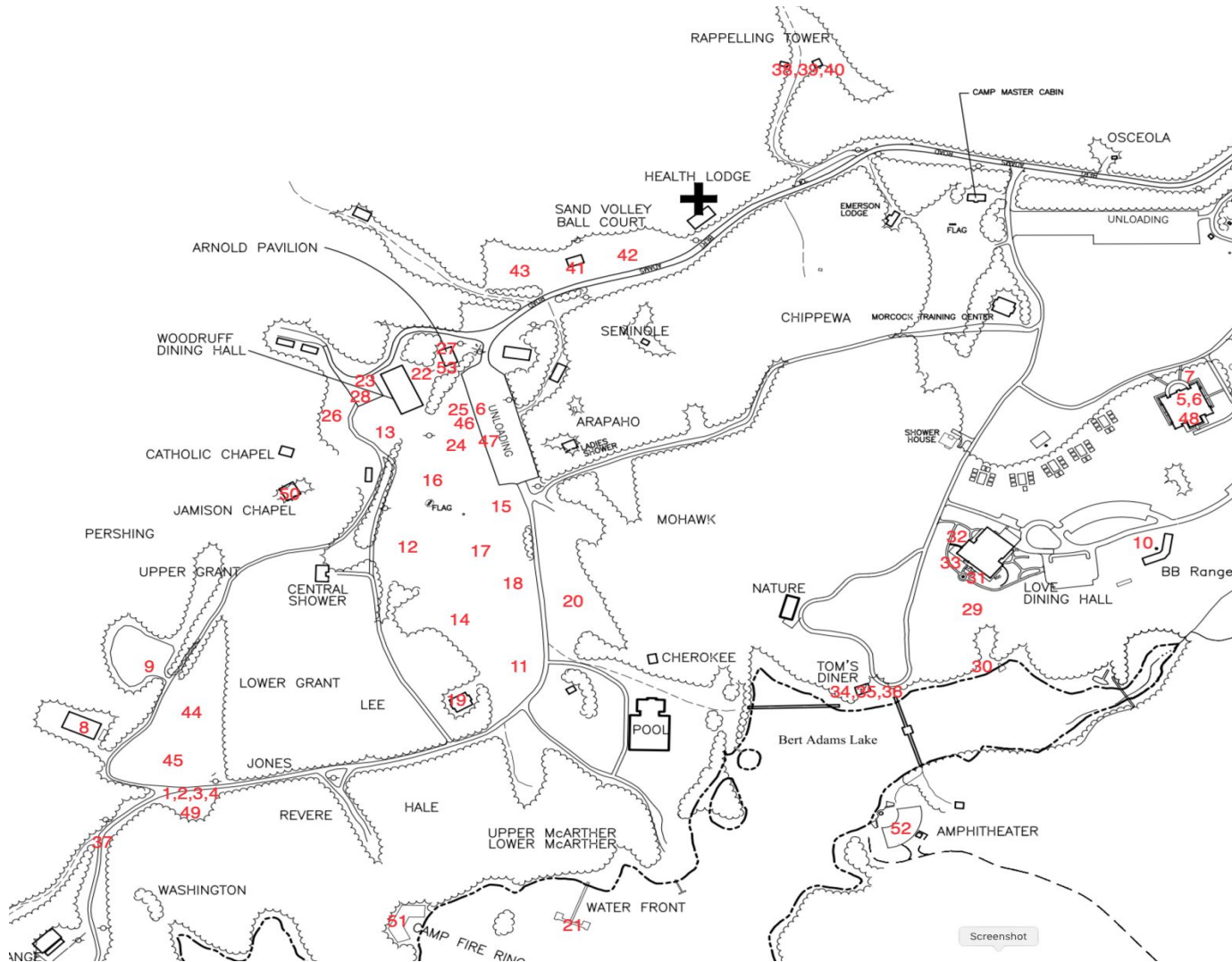

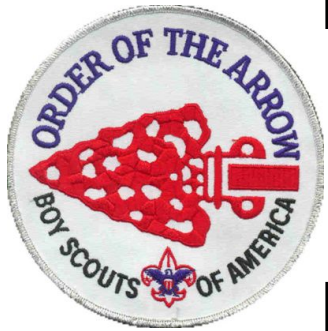

Indian sites (packed)

Parking: OFF SITE ONLY

Driver access – shuttles only

Trailers – remote from campsite

- Troop fire prevention plan
- No Axes Allowed
- Buddy System
- Swimming areas off limits.



Camping - IMPORTANT

- Trash disposal
- Clear campsites several times a day
- Bring & USE Your Trash Bags!!
- Getting the TRASH OUT is as important as Eating
- Maintain Restroom Facilities

Check In Procedure

Check-in starts at 4pm on Friday

Units will be assigned a drop-off parking lot.



Parking Card

EVERY vehicle will be given a parking card (color coded) when they enter camp.

This card must be filled out and placed on dashboard.



Check-in Process

Drive to BASC and enter camp.

CAUTIOUSLY proceed until stopped

Proceed as directed to the appropriate unloading lot.
Park where directed – Engine off, Parking brake on.
Driver should stay with car

Gear and Scouts will be off-loaded and then directed
to their campsite



Check in process-Con't

Driver will proceed to designated parking lot

Drivers will be shuttled back to join their unit

Trip Leader (adult) will need to go to registration building to pick up participant wrist bands and merchandise.

Please bring 2 copies of your unit roster.



Troop Planning is Essential

Compact tents – (Plan campsite layout)

Simplify menus and cooking gear

Minimal number of vehicles

Be **READY** for check-in

Brief youth leaders on what to expect

Be prepared to be **FLEXIBLE!**
